JIPLP: CJEU's effect on SPC jurisprudence

Partner Darren Smyth has had a guest <u>editorial</u> published in the Journal of Intellectual Property Law and Practice (JIPLP) on the subject of referrals to the Court of Justice of the European Union (CJEU) concerning the Supplementary Protection Certificate (SPC) Regulation.

Darren bemoans the situation which has been created whereby a national judge makes a referral to the CJEU because there is a particular area of uncertainty in SPC law, a judgement from the CJEU follows that fails to clarify the original uncertainty, and creates a new one.
