RSC Faces of Chemistry: Darren Smyth

Partner Darren Smyth has been featured as a 'Face of Chemistry' in a video by the Royal Society of Chemistry.

IP solicitor Robert Lundie Smith and associate Fergus Tyrrell are also interviewed in a film about <u>chemists working in patents</u>.

A camera crew visited EIP's London office and shot footage of Fergus, Robert and Darren interacting with colleagues as part of the RSC's Faces of Chemistry series, which features short videos about well-known chemists, how research leads to new products and technologies, and the types of careers a chemist may enter.
